Dear Mr. Carrión, III:

Section of 109 of the Promesa bill subject members of an Oversight Board and its staff to federal conflict of interest and financial disclosure requirements under 18 U.S.C. §208, which is the principal conflict of interest law for all executive branch officials. After consulting the United States Office of Government Ethics (OGE) and the Ethics Government Act of 1978 all members of the Board are required to submit within 30 days of their appointment their financial disclosure. The Office of Government Ethics confirmed to me that they don't have the reports of the Promesa Board Members. In such cases, is their interpretation that, the financial disclosure must have been submitted to Board itself consistent with the above reference Act.

The Act of 1978 provides a specific requirement for requesting the financial disclosure reports. Following is my official request for the reports consistent with those requirements:

I, Carlos I. Pesquera, engineer and editor of eljunte.com, 1122 Ponce de León Ave, San Juan, PR, 00925, request the financial disclosure reports for the following Financial Oversight and Management Board for Puerto Rico Members:

I am fully aware of the following prohibitions on the obtaining or use of the reports requested:

Title 1 of the Ethics in Government Act of 1978, as amended, 5 U.S.C. app. § 105(c), states that:

It shall be unlawful for any person to obtain or use a report:

- (A) for any unlawful purpose;
- (B) for any commercial purpose, other than by news and communications media for dissemination to the general public;
- (C) for determining or establishing the credit rating of any individual; or
- (D) for use, directly or indirectly, in the solicitation of money for any political, charitable, or other purpose.
